- Is not a poison or toxic
- Is colorless and odorless in its natural form. An odorant is added to it as a safety measure
- Is lighter than air and will rise and diffuse rapidly
- Is flammable when mixed with precise amounts of oxygen in the presence of an ignition source

If you smell gas:

### DO

- Leave the area
- Call Interior Gas Utility

Warn others

- DON'T
- Look for the leak
- Open any windows
- Use anything electrical, not even a phone

Call Alaska Digline at 811 for free utility locates at least 48 hours before digging. The greatest risk to pipelines is the accidental damage during excavation, so call 811, wait for the marks, and dig safely!
