

ABOUT YOUR PIPING

Dear customer,

Interior Gas Utility does not maintain the customer-installed piping - neither buried, nor above ground. If the customer's buried piping is not maintained, it may be subject to the potential hazards of corrosion and leakage.

Buried gas piping should be:

- Periodically inspected for leaks
- Periodically inspected for corrosion if the piping is metallic
- Repaired if any unsafe condition is discovered

When excavating near buried gas piping, the piping should be located in advance, and the excavation should be done by hand.

**Know what's below.
Call before you dig.**

Call Alaska Digline at 811 for free utility locates at least 48 hours before digging. The greatest risk to pipelines is the accidental damage during excavation, so call 811, wait for the marks, and dig safely!
